First, I would like to say from our family to yours Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year! We have all enjoyed the relief the cooler weather has brought us from our usually hot temperatures. With the cooler weather also comes increased rodent activity. What better place to move into than your home, office or barn.

They also are vectors for many human diseases most notably the Bubonic plague. You should never handle wild rats or mice (dead or alive) with your bare hands.

What should I do?

First, make sure all possible entry points are secured. Cracks around windows, doors, plumbing exits and ac conduits are prime entry points. You must remember if it is big enough for their head they will get the rest of their body through. Second, refrain from using ANY poison inside. If a rodent were to consume poison inside and fall down a wall the stench will be unbelievable. We always recommend traps first. If you want to use poison always use it on the outside preferably in tamper proof rodent boxes. Third, make sure any food sources are secured i.e. pet food, bird seed and trash cans. Remember preventing a rodent infestation all together is easier than curing one.
